IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL ADULT VOLUNTEERS:

Good Shepherd is committed to providing a safe environment for all children and youth. All adult volunteers are required to participate in a mandatory on-line training and give permission for a background check. The new training is a one hour on-line self-guided training course provided by the Diocese of Altoona Johnstown. This training is required for all employees, all clergy, as well as for volunteers who have ongoing contact with minors.

A link is provided on the Home Page of the Diocesan Website - www.dioceseaj.org. Look for the Youth Protection icon on left side of the Home Page. 1. Go to the website. 2. Click the icon. 3. Click on the Youth Protection Program Training Course.

Good Shepherd will pay the cost of the background check for all adults who volunteer in any part of the Faith Formation program of the parish, including VBS. People who have completed Protecting God's Children in the past are considered compliant and not required to take the new course. Background checks must be updated every 5 years.
